The Elmbridge Design Code Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) was adopted on 17 April 2024. The SPD provides design guidance relating to all new development in the borough. Its overall aim is to ensure that the design of future development is more locally responsive, sustainable and built to a high quality. It forms part of the Elmbridge Local Plan.
